

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

M6 junction 19 improvement scheme

ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSMENT

DETERMINATION UNDER SECTION 105AB (1)(b) OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT 1980 (as amended)

Highways England gives notice that it has been determined that the M6 junction 19 improvement scheme proposal which is a relevant project within the meaning of section 105ZA (2) of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended) is not subject to environmental impact assessment in accordance with Part 105A of the Highways Act 1980 (as amended).

This is due to the fact that there are no likely significant effects on the environment when taking into account the characteristics and location of the development, and the type and characteristics of the potential impacts.

This conclusion has taken into account measures to avoid or prevent significant adverse effects on the environment. A number of industry best practice mitigation measures will be delivered via a Construction Environmental Management Plan (CEMP). Project specific mitigation measures detailed within the CEMP include landscape planting, inclusion of pollution control devices within the design and appropriate pile design to manage the risk of dissolution cavities.
